***Re: Support Prevailing Wages in Huntington Beach***

Please be advised that the Huntington Beach Charter City Review Commission is holding a Town Hall meeting to receive public comments on the inclusion of language that protects prevailing wages in their amended Charter.

As you may recall, in 2002 and 2004 some members of the Huntington Beach City Council made an attempt to eliminate prevailing wages on City funded projects. Both times, with all of your help, we were successful in beating it back.

Now that the Charter is being amended we have an opportunity to insert language into the Charter that protects prevailing wages. The same as we did in Buena Park last year and Palmdale and Lancaster a few months ago.

The Craft Unions have worked very hard in preparation for this meeting for several months, to line up Employers, Employer Associations, rank and file members, especially those living in Huntington Beach and those employers who business is in Huntington Beach to speak in favor of prevailing wages.
